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THURSDAY MAY 05, 2011:

MR. LEGER: Actually Mr. Bothwell's here. We can deal with Mr. Bothwell now.

THE COURT: All right.

MR. BOTHWELL: Just so we can clarify for the record. We know it's George Hugh, it's not Mr. Bothwell, and I'd like the record to show that.

THE COURT: And, Ms Gamble are you assisting?

MS GAMBLE: I certainly spoke to George this morning; he had glasses and a bible with him that he requires in the courtroom. So I was to make that known to this Honourable Court, but George will be addressing Your Worship directly, but I am here certainly as Friend of the Court to assist.

THE COURT: All right. And you're indicating....

MR. LEGER: The Crown is prepared for a show cause hearing for Mr. George Bothwell, and it is a - it's the Crown's onus, and the Crown is prepared now to commence the show cause hearing.

THE COURT: And, are you prepared for your hearing Sir?

MR. BOTHWELL: I believe that I need my bible and my glasses, and I'm certainly not prepared to proceed into any hearing. I believe we're in a *de facto* Court here. As you can see by - if you can't hear without consent from George, you can't loop the trust of Bothwell at Thunder Bay, and under Section 15 of the *Criminal Code*, I reject a *de facto* Court, which you'll see in the dictionary is in fact illegitimate.

R. v. George Bothwell

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THE COURT: All right, well I don't want to have you go - continue with that if you're not prepared for a bail hearing then we will adjourn the matter to another date when you can be prepared. So....

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MR. BOTHWELL: Well I understood you were talking a show cause. Before anything proceeds I need this Court, and I need this Crown to state their names - given names as well on and for the record, and I also need to know under what authority they have placed Bothwell on the docket, and by what authority they decide to identify George Hugh as this corporate fictional entity Bothwell. By definition, it's some rule of law, which is false but assumed to be true.

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THE COURT: All right just....

MR. BOTHWELL: And apparently this *de facto* Court is to see that it's never disproved,...

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MR. LEGER: No, I'm,...
